Conservation Tip:

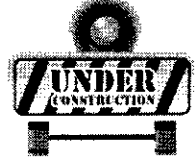


Deep-Soak Your Lawn - When watering the lawn, do it long enough for the moisture to soak down to the roots where it will do the most good. A light sprinkling can evaporate quickly and tends to encourage shallow root systems. Put an empty tuna can on your lawn—when it's full, you've watered about the right amount.

Construction News:



Avondale Phase 2 - The District will be bidding and constructing (provided we receive bids) the first portion of Avondale Phase 2. This will include Friar Drive from Ntakan Village condos to East Shore Drive. This section is being singled out first because of two existing leaks. Next year, we will do the remainder of this phase, East Shore, Saxon, Tudor and the remaining ends of Friar. Bids will



be opened on August 17th, and construction is scheduled to begin on August 31st. Completion of this first portion of Phase 2 is expected by October 21st.

Chilco Booster Pump - Chilco Booster Pump Improvement Project has been awarded to Terra Underground. Notice to Proceed will take place on July 25th. Completion is anticipated within 60 days. This will improve the Chilco System pressure and provide a steady and constant pressure.

Security Fencing Projects - The District has received grant money from the Dept. of Environmental Quality (DEQ) to secure four of our well sites. This is part of the Source Water Protection Grant funding provided by EPA to our state DEQ. Chilco, Finucane (Hillside Service Area), Hayden Orchards, and Selkirk Meadows (Atlas Acres Service Area) will each receive a fence at the well sites.

Highway 95/Chilco - Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) is now under construction for new frontage roads in the Chilco area. After these are completed, ITD's contractor will then remove and replace existing Hwy 95, turning into a four-lane divided highway. This is part of the states 'Connecting Idaho Partners' effort. Residents along the east side of Hwy 95 south of the old Rimrock Golf Course have petitioned the District for water service. These petitioners would pay for an 8" waterline extension to serve their properties.

Twin Lakes Service Area - This fall, the District is planning to replace the old 2" service line from the bridge to narrows. This line runs on the lake bottom and serves two full-time residences and about 20 seasonal lake cabins.
