Construction News:



Lancaster Road - Sunday night, October 2nd, the 12" transmission main in Lancaster Road, at the intersection of Warren Road, ruptured. Pavement in this one-year-old intersection was lifted up by the volume and pressure of water in the main causing serious damage to the sub-structure of the intersection. A costly repair is in store. As a result of this main break, and two others previously on Lancaster Road, the Board of Directors approved an emergency declaration to replace the main from just west of this intersection to Ferndale Road, immediately. Bids were solicited from four separate contractors for the work. L&L Cargile was the lowest bidder. A contract award has been issued to L&L Cargile. We expect them to start construction as early as October 25th.

Chilco Booster Station - We are nearly complete with the booster pump improvements at the Chilco pump house. Some initial startup glitches have plagued the District staff, but we have these pretty well worked out now.

Highway 95/ITD - The District has an 8" waterline in the existing Hwy 95 right-of-way that must be moved for the ITD Hwy 95 expansion project. A new utility corridor is currently being prepared for this new waterline and work is expected to begin this week. The old waterline will continue to serve those residents in the northern Chilco portion of our service area until such time as the new waterline is completed. Estimated completion is just prior to Thanksgiving.

Twin Lakes New Lake Line - A new waterline has been installed on the lake bottom between Bridge Lake Road and Fish Lake Road to serve current customers on the south side of Twin Lakes. This area is just before the narrows going to Upper Twin Lakes. The old line had metal fittings that have developed leaks from time to time. Since the line is on the lake bottom, it was necessary to replace it with a new fusion welded poly line.
