Construction News:



Chilco Waterline Replacement - ITD's Hwy 95 Garwood to Sagle project has impacted about 5,800 feet of District waterline. We have completed the installation of a new waterline to replace the main that will be destroyed this spring. In addition, a group of property owners south of the old Rimrock Golf Course requested that NKWD extend the waterline to provide service for them. These properties are paying for the waterline extension through a Local Improvement District (LID) which NKWD has formed. This 5,000 foot extension is nearly complete, and individual water services to the effected properties are currently being installed.

Lancaster Transmission Main - Construction has resumed on the transmission main from Government Way east to Ferndale. Depending on weather conditions, this work may be completed in the next three weeks.

Avondale Waterline Replacement Project - Waterline replacement will resume in the spring of this year. Timing will be dependent on winter weather conditions and early spring rains.

Don't over-water your plants! Many plants die from over-watering. When you water your plants, poke at the soil with your finger. If the soil is dry and hard, give your plants some water. If the soil is damp, leave your poor plant alone.

Remember, you must call 811 before digging for any reason, at any depth, at least 48 hours prior to digging. If you don't, and you hit a utility, you may be billed for the repairs!
