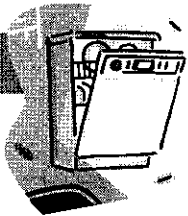

Construction News:

Lancaster Waterline - Construction is now complete on the Lancaster waterline from Warren Road to Ferndale. Services are connected and the new main is in service. The contractor will be working on some final clean up items. In the spring, the bike path that was removed west of Hwy 95 will be replaced.

Avondale Waterline Replacement - After a mild winter, construction may begin sooner than originally anticipated on Eastshore Drive and Saxon Drive. Chilco East New Waterline - Construction is now complete on the new waterline on the east side of Hwy 95 from Chilco Road north to the old Rimrock Golf Course. This waterline was funded by an LID of the property owners along this new main.

Chilco West New Waterline - Plans and specifications are now available for public bidding of this project. The bid opening is February 29, 2012. Construction of this project is estimated to begin in early March. Portions of the new 8" waterline will have to wait for traffic to be re-routed to the new frontage road, Pope Road, while existing Hwy 95 is torn up and reconstructed into a divided highway. During this reconstruction phase, the District's contractor will install a new steel casing across Hwy 95 for the new 8" waterline. Completion of this project is anticipated for late June of this year.
