If you discover you have no water at one of your inside faucets, please check additional faucets. If there is no water at one but there is water at the other, you probably have frozen pipes. You will need to thaw them out. Unfortunately, calling us will not help in this situation.

Could we please ask those wanting to receive email notifications to go to our website and click on the Go Green box. This will send you to a site where you can sign up to receive email notifications. You will also be able to see electronic statements, make payments, and manage your account. You can sign up for email statement notifications or you can skip that part and continue receiving paper statements if that is your wish.

On the site, choose New User. Fill out all the blanks. We will now be able to send you email notifications within minutes of having an emergency.
