Backflow Prevention

Passed backflow assembly tests are due into our office by June 15th. After the 15th, accounts will be subject to fines and disconnection.

Meter Reading

We made spring reading adjustments this month in our Rimrock system. Accounts that have been estimated through the winter are adjusted based on the actual consumption recorded. Also, when the meters are read, the crew paint the meter lids and trim any shrubs that obstruct access to the meter box.

Conservation Tip

The District's policy is to abstain from watering between noon and 6 p.m. During this time, the heat of the day causes water evaporation. A lot of the water goes into the sky instead of into the ground. Please water your lawn before or after this time period.



Safety Regulation

Anyone living near our well houses needs to be aware that you are not permitted to use fertilizer or bug killer within 50 feet of the well house. This is an important part of keeping our drinking water safe. Thank you for your cooperation.

You will now see your current phone number and e-mail address printed on your statement. Please let us know if our information is incorrect. This can be very important in the event of a water emergency. Thank you for your assistance.

Automated Payments

If you are interested in having your payment made automatically, we have a few different options for you.

You may go to our website and sign up to access your account online. Once you have your online account, you can choose to have your account paid through a recurring payment with your credit or debit card. This payment will be made automatically around the 10th of the month.

You may fill out an ACH form to have the payment come from your checking account automatically each month. You have the choice to have the payment withdrawn around the 1st or the 10th of the month. This form can be found on our website or you can call the office and request the form be sent to you.

You can also go online and make a payment to us through your bank. These payments can be set up to come out automatically but the totals will not match your statement and should be monitored each month. In most cases, the bank will send us a check. It can take up to 10 days for us to receive this payment. Therefore, you should set the payment to be sent by the 5th of the month to prevent the payment from being late.
