Snowbirds

If you are leaving for the winter and want your water meter shut-off, call the office to schedule. Remember that in the spring when you return, we need 48 hours notice to have the meter turned back on.

You can also call the office if you are leaving for the winter and want to keep your water meter on but want your water usage estimated at 0 gallons. This will keep you from paying for unused water during the winter months. If you do not call the office and you are charged during the winter for unused water, it will be corrected in the form of a credit on your water statement after the first spring meter read.
