Construction Projects... by the time most of you read this, Barack Obama will be sworn in as this nation's 44th president. President Elect Obama has set his sights on providing new jobs by implementing an aggressive economic stimulus package. Stimulus money will be distributed to the states for road, bridge, and infrastructure projects that are ready to go in the spring of 2009. Let's hope that Idaho realizes some of this federal money and that it trickles down to the local level.

Water and sewer projects, as well as road projects, are among many of the proposed projects for the stimulus package. The Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) is currently working on a local segment of Hwy 95, from Wyoming to SH 53, to have it ready for bidding and construction. We have two water line crossings in this area that we'd have the opportunity to upgrade if the project becomes a reality.

The District does not have any major construction projects scheduled for this year. The only exceptions would be if Walgreen's in Hayden, and Wal-Mart in Hayden, break ground. These improvements are developer driven improvements, and construction costs will be paid by the developers.
