## Notes From The Office:

**Holiday Hours:** The office will be closed December 25 & 26, 2008 and January 1 & 2, 2009.

**Board Seats ~** An election will be held on February 3, 2009, to fill 3 board seats. If you are interested in filling one of these seats, the **cutoff** for District candidates to file their 'Declaration of Candidacy' with NKWD is Wednesday, **December 24th, 2008, at 12:00 noon.**

**Construction Update ~** Although it's not too wintry yet, construction on our facilities has ended for the winter months.

**Meter Readings ~** The District field crews are in the process of reading meters for what is likely the last time of the winter season. Normally October is our final reading month; but due to a mild November and December, we've been able to read the meters. For the months of January ~ March (?), we'll estimate water usage based on the history of your account. In April (or the first month we read your meter again) your account will be adjusted based on your actual usage.
