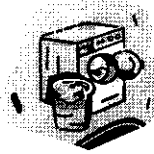

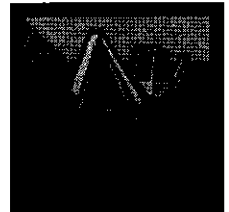
Conservation Tip:

When doing your laundry, select the appropriate water level for the load you are washing. If looking to replace an old clothes washer, consider a water-saving frontload washer.

Winter is normally a time of minimum water usage. For most customers, the District is estimating your water usage over the winter months based on your historical averages. If you see water running, hear the sound of water escaping a pipe, or notice a spot that normally would be covered in snow and is now void of snow, call us. There may be a leak.

Construction News:

Rimrock ~ Many of you served in the Rimrock area, have been waiting for increased pressure. The booster station improvements are nearly complete. We do, however, have some steel waterlines in St. James and Sherwood Court that we were unable to replace last summer. St. James and Sherwood will be in the new pressure zone, and with old steel lines there is a risk of increasing leaks due to higher pressures. This section of waterline is the first to be replaced in the spring of 2011. Our engineer is recommending that we delay increasing the pressure to the new pressure zone until St. James and Sherwood is complete. We estimate this to be installed by late May or early June.



Avondale ~ Avondale Waterline Project-Phase 2 will be going to bid in April of this year. Streets affected by the project are St. James, Sherwood Court, Friar Drive, Saxon, Eastshore, and Tudor.

Lancaster Road - Government Way to Ferndale ~ This year Lakes Highway District will begin work on this segment of Lancaster Road. During the construction, NKWD will be installing a new 16" transmission main in the right of way. This will provide additional transmission capacity to the Rimrock Service Area. The two districts, Lakes Highway District and North Kootenai Water District will coordinate the work on this section of road.
