## **Revenue Bond Election**

As a result of the recent Revenue Bond Election held on August 4th, where the voters cast ballots in favor of a new revenue bond, your October 2009 statement will reflect the following changes: the existing bond for \$3.82 will be paid off and a new bond for \$6.94 will appear. The additional amount of \$3.12 per month will allow the District to proceed immediately with Capital Improvement projects which would otherwise have been held off to the future.

## **Construction**



- ◆ **The Falls at Hayden Lake** is almost complete on the installation of new water mains within the development. The Falls at Hayden Lake consists of 46 single family parcels located on English Point Road east of Strahorn Road. This subdivision's contribution to the existing water system will include a significant pump station upgrade to the Springrock Booster Pump Station, a fractional share of a future well, and a fractional share of a new transmission main.
- ◆ **Hayden Well #2** ~ On September 17th the District will have opened bids on the completion of Hayden Well #2. The well was drilled last fall. The completion phase will include a new well pump, related electrical controls, underground piping, and a new well house.
- ◆ **Point Hayden Water Line Replacement** ~ steel water mains in the Point Hayden area are planned to be replaced in the summer of 2010.
- ◆ **Springrock Booster Station Upgrades** ~ To increase system pressure in the northern Avondale Additions, new pumps and 3 phase power will be added to the existing Springrock Booster Station.
- ◆ **Echo Beach Pump Station Improvements** ~ This pump station is in need of replacement.
- ◆ **Planned Projects** ~ the District is currently doing the survey work in Avondale for the water main project scheduled for Spring of 2010. The District is working with Lakes Highway District on a cooperative effort for street repaving in conjunction with this project.



## **Other Items**

**Conservation Measures** ~ The District would like to thank all of you for doing your part to conserve water during this summer season. In our area, we experienced 20 days of 90° or higher temperatures. In spite of this, our overall water usage in August was lower by 4.9% from the prior August!

**Digging** ~ Remember, you must call 811 before digging for any reason, at any depth, at least 48 hours prior to digging. **Locates Are Free, Repairs Are Not!**
