Notes From The Office:



We at North Kootenai Water District would like to wish each of you a very Merry Christmas & Happy (but safe) New Year!

Some of you have requested 'paperless' billing (email statements). We'd like to know if there is enough interest in this option. This month, if you'd like to have the paperless option, please note this on your return statement. Of course we will always continue to offer the conventional mailed statements.

Remember, you must call **811** before digging for any reason, at any depth, at least **48 hours** prior to digging. **Locates Are Free, Repairs Are Not!**

Construction Update:

- ◆ **Hayden Well #2** ~ The District is working on major improvements to our Hayden Well site. Well #2, which was drilled last year, is now in the pump house, piping, and electrical stage of construction. This well will provide additional water to the Hillside Service area and the Honeysuckle Hills area.
- ◆ **Walmart** ~ By now everyone has seen the construction taking place on Honeysuckle and Hwy 95 for the new Walmart SuperCenter. The stores impact on the Hayden Pines/Grouse Meadows system for additional fire flows will mean new improvements to the main pump station serving this area. Walmart, as well as other new developments on this system, are funding the improvements.
- ◆ **2010 Projects** ~ Currently under design is the much needed Avondale steel waterline replacement project. This will also include the Point Hayden area. Our goal is to be ready for public bids in late February or early March. Along with this project, we are also planning for upgrades to the pressure booster system at our
- ◆ Springrock reservoir site.

Conservation Update:

The Board of Directors is currently reviewing revisions to our Conservaton Plan. We'd like to hear from you, our constituents on conservation measures you'd like to see implemented.

With the winter cold temperatures it's important to keep an eye out for broken pipes. Moving water in very cold temperatures indicates that a pipe may have broken. Please report suspected leaks to the District office so we can investigate them.
